

JUNIOR CLUB LADDER RULES

- RULE 1: A player not on the ladder, may only challenge one of the bottom four players on the ladder, except during the period for OPEN challenges 18 October to 16 November 2008
- RULE 2: A player on the ladder, may only challenge a player three positions higher than the challenger, except during the period of OPEN challenges .
- RULE 3: The Junior Administrator reserves the right to arrange special challenges, including one open challenge for a new member and to adjust the ladder on the basis of the result obtained.
- RULE 4: A player is permitted only one challenge at any one time.
- RULE 5: A player is not permitted to challenge a person already challenged.
- RULE 6: The challenger is to write up the challenge giving the date and player challenged and then notify the player challenged within 24 hours.
- RULE 7: All matches must be played within ten days of the date of the challenge.
- RULE 8: All matches are to be on Club courts unless agreed by both parties. All matches are played as per interclub. 12 years and under first to 6. 13 years and over are the best of 17 games, 12 point tie breaker at 8 all (up to 9, with a tie breaker at 8 all).
If a younger player is challenging an older player the game will be played as per the older persons interclub games.
- RULE 9: The challenger is to provide good used balls acceptable to both players.
- RULE 10: A challenged player cannot be rechallenged by the same player within twenty one days of the previous challenge.
- RULE 11: If the player challenged defaults the match, his or her position on the ladder shall automatically become one place below the position of the challenger and the remaining position on the ladder shall be adjusted accordingly.
- RULE 12: If a player is unable to participate in ladder challenges, due to sickness or injury, his or her name may be removed from the ladder at the discretion of the Junior Administrator. If removal occurs under this rule, the player concerned shall have the right to challenge on application to the Junior Administrator.
- RULE 13: If the Junior Administrator considers that a player has ceased to be an active participant in ladder challenges, then after consultation with the player concerned, his or her name may be removed from the ladder.

RULE 14: All disputes are to be referred to the Junior Administrator, in writing, and their decision shall be final.

RULE 15: The ladder will be updated from the result sheet, weekly.
